Position: Summer Day Camp Junior Counselor (5 positions)

Accountability: Reports to Children's Program Coordinator and Senior Counselors

Major Duties:

- Assists in the planning and implementing of sports, recreational and educational activities for campers
- Supervises children participating in sports, arts and recreational programming including day trips
- Ensures safety, security, nutrition, health and hygiene of campers
- Responds to conflict and behavioral issues appropriately
- Helps to maintain proper care, safety and security of equipment and facilities
- Follows agency policies, procedures and mandates
- Participates in staff meetings and training sessions
- Ensures activities are of excellent quality and appropriate to the healthy development of children

Qualifications:

- Enrolled in related post-secondary program including Social Recreation, Physical Education, Child and Youth work, etc.
- At least 1 year of front line work/volunteer experience with children in small and large group settings
